Landlord-tenant law includes rights and obligations each landlord and each tenant has with regard to the rental property. Both parties need to know the basics of renting a place, how to collect or pay security deposits, the basics of state and federal laws regarding fair housing, and more.

Landlord-tenant law governs the rental of commercial and residential property. It is composed primarily of state statutes and common law. A number of states have based their statutory law on either the Uniform Residential Landlord And Tenant Act (URLTA) or the Model Residential Landlord-Tenant Code.

Several other landlord-tenant laws in Kentucky affect both property owners and renters, including: restrictions on landlord's right to access rental

property (Kentucky landlords must provide two days' notice of entry) tenant protections against landlord retaliation for tenant exercising a legal right, such as complaining about an unsafe living condition (see Kentucky State Laws Prohibiting Landlord Retaliation for details)

The Residential Landlord and Tenant Act that pertains to standard rental housing was enacted to govern the rental of dwelling units and the rights and obligations of landlord and tenant. The document can be downloaded for free. There is currently no state agency that enforces provisions in the Act, and because most landlord/tenant relations are private transactions, disputes that arise between landlord and tenants are generally considered private matters.

Under state law, California landlords must disclose specific information to tenants (usually in the lease or rental agreement), such as whether the gas or electricity in the tenant's rental also serves other areas and information about toxic mold if the landlord knows that mold on the property exceeds exposure limits or poses a threat to the tenant's health.

State law provides a legal framework for the relationship between landlords and tenants. Many disputes between landlords and tenants can be avoided if both parties understand their legal rights and responsibilities.

State laws specify when and how a landlord may terminate a tenancy. For example, a landlord may give a New Mexico tenant who has repeatedly violated a term of the rental agreement within six months an unconditional quit notice that gives the tenant seven days to move out before the landlord can file for eviction.

A tenant must notify the landlord, in writing, by hand delivery or mail, of noncompliance with Florida law or the requirements of the rental agreement. The written notice shall also indicate the tenant's intention to terminate the rental agreement due to this noncompliance.

Landlord Tenant Rights In Texas, a written or oral lease exists when a landlord accepts regular payment for inhabiting property. According to Texas law (TX Property Code Chapter 92), a lease grants certain rights to the tenant, such as the right to a habitable dwelling and the right to take at least one form of alternative action.

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
